



**Kanawha County Adolescent Immunization Campaign
Rules and Regulations for Prize Drawing
Contest Timeframe: January 1st to December 31st, 2008**

1. What are the Grand Prizes*?

Grand Prizes: Dell® Laptop Computers
Second Prizes: iPod Touch's®
Third Prizes: Gift Packages

2. Who Is Eligible to Win? Anyone between the ages of 11 and 21 by December 31, 2008 residing in Kanawha County, West Virginia or who attends a Kanawha County college or university and has completed their age appropriate recommended immunizations according to CDC/ACIP* which include:

- a. Tetanus, Diphtheria, Acellular Pertussis (Td as indicated)
- b. Hepatitis B
- c. Varicella
- d. Measles, Mumps, Rubella
- e. Meningococcal
- f. Human Papillomavirus (female only)

Immunizations successfully completed before 2008 will be accepted but all recommended immunizations must be completed by December 31, 2008. Persons who have completed two of the three series of HPV or HBV by December 31, 2008 and have scheduled the third vaccination by January 31, 2009 will be eligible to enter. One entry per person.

3. Who is Ineligible? Any employee or immediate family member of the Kanawha-Charleston Health Department, The Board of Health for Kanawha County, immediate family of participating providers, or members of the Kanawha County "Take Your Best Shot" Planning Committee. Immediate family includes children, grandchildren, brothers, sisters, adopted and step-members.

4. How Does the Drawing Work? Participating providers' offices will complete a postcard outlining the required immunizations and return to patient or parent/guardian. It is the patient/parent's responsibility to return the postcard to KCHD postmarked by December 31, 2008. On January 5, 2009 a random drawing for prizes will be held. The winners will be notified by certified mail and posted on www.kchdvw.com website. Each winner will have seven calendar days after receipt of certified prize letter to contact KCHD to claim prizes and all unclaimed prizes will be redistributed by January 31, 2009. All medical records and eligibility of the winners will be verified. If unable to verify records another winner will be selected. Proof of Kanawha County residency and guardianship will also be verified.
