KCHD Holds Flu Vaccine Clinic at Wal-Mart

The Kanawha-Charleston Health Department (KCHD) will hold a H1N1 and Seasonal Influenza Vaccination Clinic on Saturday, March 6h from 10:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. at the Southridge Wal-Mart. The clinic is open to everyone and the vaccines are FREE of charge. KCHD will be set-up by the pharmacy. Children including those under ten years old who have not received their second dose at least four weeks after their initial dose are encouraged to attend.

“The H1N1 flu activity is continuing to level off but the virus is still circulating” states Dr. Rahul Gupta, KCHD Health Officer. “We are remaining vigilant and warning against public complacency. The best protection against the virus still remains that through vaccination.”

KCHD is also holding clinics at 108 Lee Street, East in Charleston from 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. every Monday through Friday for any individual who still needs the H1N1 or Seasonal Influenza Vaccine.
