H1N1 Clinic for Kanawha County Children

The Kanawha-Charleston Health Department will hold an H1N1 Vaccine Clinic for children 6 months to 5 years of age who are not currently enrolled in school. The clinic will be **Saturday, November 14th from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. at St. Albans High School** at 2100 Kanawha Terrace in St. Albans. Children who are home schooled are also eligible to attend. Another clinic for this age group will be held on Saturday, November 21st at another location in Kanawha County. A parent or guardian must accompany the children.

The Kanawha-Charleston Health Department is planning to continue its H1N1 vaccination clinics at the Health Department for pregnant women and children with chronic illnesses each **Thursday from 12.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m.** The Health Department is located at 108 Lee Street, East in Charleston.
