## **KANAWHA COUNTY H1N1 VACCINE CLINICS**

**For the week of November 2, 2009**

This week, the Kanawha-Charleston Health Department and their partners will be providing H1N1 vaccinations to children in the following schools:

- Monday, November 2<sup>nd</sup>: Shoals Ruffner, Bonham and Sissonville Elementary Schools
- Tuesday, November 3<sup>rd</sup>: King Center Daycare
- Wednesday, November 4<sup>th</sup>: Watts, Flinn, Robins, and St. Anthony's Elementary Schools
- Thursday, November 5<sup>th</sup>: Grandview and Chandler Elementary Schools
- Friday, November 6<sup>th</sup>: Piedmont and Glenwood Elementary Schools and Vista View Pre-School.

In addition to the school clinics, the Health Department will hold the following clinics:

- A clinic for Chronically Ill Adults between the ages of 19 to 64 years on **Tuesday, November 3 from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.** at the Health Department at 108 Lee Street, East.
- A clinic for children who are not currently enrolled in school or home schooled as well as those in the Charleston daycares and preschools on **Thursday, November 5 from 3:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.**
- The Health Department is planning to continue its H1N1 vaccination clinics at the Health Department for pregnant women and children with chronic illnesses each **Thursday from 12.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m.**
